Building Confidence in a Friendly Environment

Impact Dance encourages its students by placing them in classes according to their ability to learn a high standard of dance and theatre skills in a friendly, confidence-building atmosphere.

What Do We Teach?

Classes are available in the disciplines of Jazz, Street Funk, Tap (a.d.a.p. and G.W.T.), Ballet (R.A.D.) and Contemporary dance. We also offer Singing and Drama classes to build theatre and stage skills. Exams may be taken at regular intervals by the students. Private lessons are also available upon request.



Classes – by age groups

Toddlers (3-4 years) & Primary (5-7 years)

Jazz & Tap – 1 hour classes

This class introduces children to basic movements in jazz/funk & tap. We incorporate singing and drama to make the class interesting and exciting, but at a basic level with which the children of this age can cope. This class helps the children with co-ordination, timing and rhythm and helps them progress to the next class.

(8-10 Years)

Junior Jazz/Funk – 1 hour classes

This class teaches all styles of jazz/funk. Students receive tuition according to their ability and dance to the latest styles of music trends to which the students can relate.

Classes – for children and adults

Tap

These classes teach beginners to advanced students in this very exciting form of dance. Students learn all styles of tap dancing, from the traditional to the very latest styles.

Ballet

Ballet is the basis of all dances. It derives strength, flexibility but most importantly technique. Versatility is the key to a great performer.

Contemporary Dance

Modern dance is valuable to any dancer's training as it provides them with an opportunity to express themselves through dance and develop their skills and strength.

Singing, Drama & Stage Performance

Students are encouraged to perform short plays, musicals, and vocal performances in various venues to gain experience performing.
